Conference scope and topics

The 1st Algerian-German International Conference on New Technologies and their Impact on Society (AGICNT) is to be held at the University Ferhat Abbas - Sétif (Algeria) in May 2008. The AGICNT conference organizers and committee are working to provide an exciting and engaging forum for you to explore, understand and develop your interest and involvement in new technologies and their impact on society. All abstract submissions undergo peer-review.

Topics of interest include, but are not restricted to, the following:

- **Optronics**
- **Solar Energy**
- **New Information and Communication Technologies (ICTs)**

We invite contributions from members of both the engineering sciences and the social sciences with experience of exploring, developing, applying and evaluating new technologies and/or their impact on society. The conference aims to foster interdisciplinary discussions on new technologies and their implications.

Part of the conference is the **Satellite Meeting: "Three Decades of Algerian-German Cooperation in Optics and Electronics"**.

The conference is organized by the University Ferhat Abbas - Sétif (Algeria) together with the University of Ilmenau (Germany). Both universities look back on a history of more than 25 years of intercultural cooperation in the field of new technology teaching and research. As an Algerian-German conference AGICNT aims to promote inter-cultural exchange on new technologies and their impact on more or less developed countries.

Conference Venue

AGICNT 2008 will be held at the Ferhat Abbas University in Sétif, Algeria. Sétif (www.univ-setif.dz) is a university city with about 230.000 inhabitants, located in the north eastern part of Algeria, approximately 300 km east of Algiers on the highway to Constantine.

Today about forty thousand students strong, the Ferhat Abbas University of Sétif UFAS (www.univ-setif.dz) opened in 1978 and is organized around six faculties.



Abstract Preparation and Submission

The abstract will be used by the Program Committee as the sole basis for acceptance of the paper for presentation. Thus, the abstract should clearly communicate the new and significant results that have been obtained. Presentation time is 20 minutes plus 10 minutes for discussion.

Abstracts should clearly state

- Title of the presentation
- Names and affiliations of all co-authors
- Complete contact information (e-mail, phone, mailing address) of the first (presenting) author
- Objective of the work
- Methods / techniques used
- Main results

Abstract length:	400 words (one page)
Abstract language:	English or French
Abstract submission:	Via e-mail or postal mail
Abstract submission deadline:	December 01, 2007
Abstract acceptance notification:	January 31, 2008

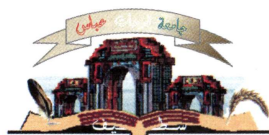
